

Members Travel Experience


None of our members has sent any details of any of their holidays so I have included a previous trip last year that Maureen and I did which may interest some.

We started in Paris for 3 days then a fast train to the French Riviera, then a coach tour to Genoa where we boarded our cruise ship. We went to Rome, Sicily, Athens, Santorini, Mykonos, Istanbul, Kusadasi all of which we had been to previously then were due to sail down the Suez Canal to visit Petra then Egypt.

Due to the Gaza conflict we had to return to Rome and fly to Cairo to start our Egypt adventure which was the main reason for the trip. We were disappointed to miss out on the Suez and Petra but Egypt was the main item on our bucket list. From Cairo we flew to Luxor to see Karnak Temple and the Valley of the Kings and did a balloon flight over the top then had a 4-day Nile Cruise via Edfu, Kom Ombo and Aswan where you see the high dam and Abu Simbel. We then flew back to Cairo to see the Museum and saw the 3 main pyramids and the Sphinx. I also had the opportunity to climb inside the Great pyramid to see the burial chamber which was a great experience.

Egypt is hot, dirty, corrupt and crowded but if you get the chance, you must see it. You will be in awe at the colossal size of the monuments which can't be seen elsewhere. Documentaries you see do not do justice to just how vast these monuments are and you are awe struck when you actually see them.

The wealth and knowledge of the ancient Egyptians to build these is mind blowing.




